Terms and Conditions applying to Camping and Mooring

General Terms and Conditions

- Completion of booking is deemed as an acceptance of the terms and conditions of booking.
- No refunds are given for any cancellations of stay, early departures or poor weather.
- We do not accept commercial vehicles.
- Use of the tent area is available to HRR crews, spectators and supporters only.
- All bookings are at the discretion of Henley Rowing Club.
- All rubbish to be disposed of correctly in the bins provided.
- We have a zero tolerance policy to anti-social behaviour.
- The management reserves the right to refuse entry.
- Cars may be parked in the car park by arrangement with hrr@henleyrowing.club. There is an additional charge for this.
- Please ensure there is no excessive noise after 9:30pm and keep noise levels to a minimum after 10:30pm.
- Please be considerate to our neighbours, including those living on Rod Eyot Island, opposite the Club.
- Failure to pay camping/mooring fees will result in immediate eviction from the site.
- Dogs are not permitted on site.
- Generators are not permitted.
- The use of anti-social toys, such as bb guns, electric or motorized scooters/toys etc. is prohibited.
- Under 18 year olds remain the responsibility of their parents/guardians at all times. Young people must not be left without adult supervision on HRC premises and adults should not allow parties to be held in their absence at any time.
- Henley Rowing Club accepts no responsibility for any loss or damage to our guests' property; including, but not limited to vehicles, personal belongings, cash and electronic equipment, however caused during your stay, including extreme weather conditions. Personal belongings are left entirely at your own risk.

Camping specific Terms and Conditions

- No camping without prior approval.
- Tents are required to stay on their allocated pitch as directed for the duration of their stay.
- No ball games or cycling around the tent area.
- Strictly NO open fires.
- Sleeping in cars is prohibited.
- Camper vans may be permitted with specific permission.

Mooring Specific Terms and Conditions

- Boats must moor to the pontoon and location allocated for the duration of their stay.
- Other boats may be moored alongside, as directed by HRC.
